
# Introduction to the CIAS **Quick Exit** feature

The new Quick Exit feature in CIAS allows participants to quickly exit an intervention in case of an emergency or situation where privacy is compromised.


### Step 1

To use the Quick Exit feature in your CIAS Intervention, navigate to the session page and click "Intervention Settings."



## Step 2

The following pop-up will appear. Click the "Quick Exit" toggle, so that it changes from gray to purple. Click the "Apply global changes" button.




#### **Preview**

Note: You can preview your intervention to see how the Quick Exit option will appear to users on different devices.



## PC Users (no touch screen)


PC users (without a touchscreen feature) can exit the intervention by pressing their computer's escape button twice, or by clicking the orange box with the X at any time throughout the intervention.



# PC Users (with touch screen)

Participants using a touch screen PC will receive both Quick Exit messages. First they will receive instructions to exit via touch screen, followed by the escape/exit buttons.





#### **Mobile Users**

Mobile users can exit the intervention with a two-finger long press anywhere on the screen for 1 second at any point during the intervention.
