



# Reflecting Participant's Name

This guide provides step by step instructions on how to reflect a participant's name throughout your intervention.

## Step 1

From the Screen Creation page, add a name screen by clicking “+ Add new screen.” Select the screen type, **Name**. (Note: We suggest adding this screen toward the beginning of your intervention.)

- Single answer
- Multi answer
- Free Response
- Date**
- Name**
- Currency
- Number
- Grid
- Slider

**Step 2** Navigate to the first screen where you want the narrator to call the participant by their name. Select 'Narrator' under Screen details. Click the green '+ Add block' button and select 'Speech.'

Choose type of block

- Speech**
- Body Animation
- Head Animation
- Pause

### Step 3

Type or paste the text you want the narrator to read into the text box. Insert **.:name:.** before, after or within the text, depending on where you want the narrator to reflect. In order to work properly, you must follow the exact format above. (Note: Text written in speech blocks will only be heard by participants and will not be visible on screen)

Open any block to reposition the Narrator.

1. Speech

Reset Narrator to previous block position

Select Speech Animation

Rest

Use Reflection
